Commander Salmey gave a staffing update regarding Officer Quinlan and CSO Powell. There have been sporadic applications submitted to the department, but not enough to support a new testing process.

The Chief proceeded on with the department update. Matthew Becker did come down from the billboard and Investigator Mitch Nelson is following up on the whereabouts of Mr. Becker. Investigator Lacey Radosevich did a fantastic job with a case that came out of Burnsville last February. She was able to get a conviction for an arson/attempted homicide case for which the suspect will be incarcerated for the next five years. Sergeant Michael Dahl and Officer Aaron Schmidt did an amazing job rescuing an elderly female from a house fire on the south end of town. Officer James Silda will be coming back to the department starting in January of 2025. Finally, Officers Quinlan, Powell and Walek will be recognized in front of city council on January 21st, 2025.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Commissioner Francis and seconded by Commissioner Woodburn. Motion passed (3-0).
