Commissioner Woodburn called the meeting to order at 10:00AM.

Motion to approve the agenda for the regular meeting of Monday, October 6th, 2025, was made by Commissioner Lagoo and seconded by Commissioner Francis. Motion passed (3-0)

Motion to approve the civil service regular meeting minutes for September 8th, 2025, was made by Commissioner Francis and seconded by Commissioner Lagoo. Motion passed (3-0).

The Chief proceeded with the staff updates. He provided a brief update regarding the three cadets in the ICPOET program — Timothy Neirby, Katharine Kitchen, and Karldy Schadt — and expressed optimism for their successful completion of the program and the FTO process, noting what that will mean for department staffing levels. He extended his thanks to all staff for assisting with the onboarding of the new cadets and for making them feel welcome.

The Chief then discussed the Grand Jury indictment for First Degree Murder against Jacob Audie, commending Investigator Eric Peot for his outstanding work in securing the indictment. He also provided an update on the most recent homicide case currently being investigated by Investigator Fuchs, expressing appreciation to everyone involved for their excellent work on these complex and challenging cases.

Lastly, the Chief addressed the topic of school security, highlighting both public and private schools and the successes achieved in that area. He concluded by discussing the “On the Road Again” event, noting its success and thanking all who participated for helping make it such a positive experience for the community.

Commissioner Francis would like to thank everyone involved in making On the Road again a success.
