Commissioner Woodburn called the meeting to order at 10:00AM.

Motion to approve the agenda for the regular meeting of Monday, November 3rd, 2025, was made by Commissioner Lagoo and seconded by Commissioner Francis. Motion passed (3-0)

Motion to approve the civil service regular meeting minutes for October 6th, 2025, was made by Commissioner Francis and seconded by Commissioner Lagoo. Motion passed (3-0).

The Chief proceeded with the department update. The *On the Road Again* event went very well, with the exception of one negative interaction that was handled professionally and respectfully. Thank you to those who addressed this situation.

The Chief then discussed the multiple homicide cases that resulted in guilty convictions during October, as well as the 1st-degree homicide charge filed against Jacob Audie. Unfortunately, within that same week, we also experienced another homicide.

The three cadets are currently participating in their ICPOET program, which will continue over the next couple of months, and they are expected to complete the program mid-February.

The school district is working on its emergency management and student reunification plan in preparation for potential active shooter or large-scale event. This process includes a one to two-month tabletop exercise involving all relevant agencies.

Officer James Silda is working on a large-scale fraud/theft case involving trailer sales. Unfortunately, the stolen funds cannot be returned to the victims; however, the suspect is currently incarcerated in Texas.

Lastly, the Farmington Police Department recently suffered the loss of their SRO Peter Zajac. Commander Salmey has stepped in to assist Farmington with funeral planning, and our department has provided support and coverage while they navigate this tragic event. Thank you to those who have stepped in to help.

There was no other business before the Commission.

A motion to adjourn the meeting was made by Commissioner Lagoo and seconded by Commissioner Francis. Motion passed (3-0). The meeting was adjourned at 10:23 AM
