The Chief proceeded with the department update. It has been a relatively quiet month, during which the department launched a new Department Dashboard. This initiative is designed to provide the public with greater transparency by offering access to crime statistics, crime mapping, and public-facing Flock and ALPR data. These pages are updated regularly to ensure the public remains informed and better understands department activities and how this information is utilized.

The department and city staff also participated in a roundtable exercise focused on emergency management planning for a large-scale disaster. This discussion included coordination with the school district and explored how such an event would impact their operations and overall city response.

A special acknowledgment goes to Officer Lacey Radosevich for her detailed investigative work that led to securing a Third-Degree Homicide charge related to a drug overdose that occurred in 2023. Additionally, congratulations to Sergeant Matt Case on graduating from the 12-week Northwest School of Police Command. Excellent work by both.

The Commissioners would like to extend their congratulations to Officer Radosevich and Sergeant Case on their successes. The Commissioners would also like to wish everyone a very Merry Christmas.
